### **Crisis Services Facilitator**

The hours include day, evenings and possibly weekends. **Hourly rate: \$14.00 - \$16.00 an hour**

#### **General Summary of Responsibilities**

Under general supervision, the Crisis Services Facilitator provides crisis intervention and supportive services at Sojourner House.

#### **Qualifications**

Applicants must have a minimum of 2 years of college in human services or related fields, or high school diploma and minimum of 2 years' experience with domestic violence issues.

#### **Additional Information**

Applicants must have demonstrated experience working with diverse populations, be a "self-starter", and possess excellent record keeping, customer service, written and oral communication and organization skills. Experience with Microsoft Office computer applications is a plus. The individual in this position must also have a valid Michigan driver's license and reliable transportation. Applicants must exhibit a high level of energy, a positive attitude, strong attention to detail and professionalism.
