WHAT TO BRING

Already Registered?

- Mask
- Black Pen
- Driver's License or Photo ID such as US Passport if you have it (ID is not required to vote but bring ID if you have it in case you are asked)
- Filled out ballot request form to save time when you get there (form attached)

Need to Register?

- Mask
- Black Pen
- Filled out registration and ballot request forms to save time when you get there (forms attached)
- Driver's License or Social Security Number
- Proof of residency After October 19th, bring an acceptable proof of residency document that shows both your name and address.
 - Examples are a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck or government check.



IMPORTANT EARLY VOTING TIPS!

- ξ Use your black pen and write neatly.
- ξ Follow all instructions exactly for your vote to be counted.
 - ξ Place ballot inside secrecy sleeve.
- ξ Place secrecy sleeve inside postage-paid green and white envelope.
 - ξ Be sure to sign the back of the envelope.
 - ξ Return your completed ballot to the Drop Box at City Hall.



ALTERNATIVE: VOTE IN PERSON NOVEMBER 3RD

REGISTER TO VOTE ASAP

Register to vote online with a Michigan Driver's license or State ID at www.tinyurl.com/MIRegisterOnline before October 19th.

After October 19th, follow the instructions in the previous section to register to vote in person at City Hall or Election Central. While you can register on November 3rd at designated locations, you cannot register at your polling place, so we recommend registering well ahead of Election Day.

© CONFIRM YOU ARE REGISTERED TO VOTE

Check to make sure you are registered to vote in advance of Election Day at www.tinyurl.com/MIVoter2020

- **FIND YOUR POLLING PLACE** | Find your polling location at https://tinyurl.com/MIPolls2020
- **ARRIVE EARLY** | Prepare to arrive as early in the day as possible. The polls are open from 7am to 8pm. Get there before 7am if possible.
- **BRING PHOTO ID IF YOU HAVE IT** | Although Photo ID is not required to vote, it speeds up the process. Without a Photo ID, there is an option to sign an affidavit at the polls and then cast your ballot.
- PREPARE FOR LONG LINES | It is unknown whether you will be able to get in and out in 20 minutes or 9 hours. Show up prepared and ready to wait for a long time!
- **YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO VOTE** | If you are in line when the polls close, stay in line. Anyone in line must be allowed to vote.
